# **Community Engagement Survey 2025**

## Why Digital

We are moving to a fully digital format for this survey. This decision has not been taken lightly, but it has become necessary. Producing, delivering, and processing thousands of paper surveys places a significant burden on our small team of volunteers. In our most recent round, over 2,000 paper copies were distributed, yet fewer than 100 were returned. The low response rate, combined with the high cost and time involved, makes this approach unsustainable.

If you do not have access to a mobile device or computer, **free internet and computer access** is available at **Airyhall Library**. Library staff are also on hand to assist with operating the computers if required.
